Job Summary: We want to create a safe and peaceful environment that young people feel they belong and where they love to be. The bi-vocational Next Generation Pastor will focus on overseeing the Youth Ministry of Vancouver Chinese Pentecostal Church. The Next Generation Pastor will be tasked to reach out the youth in our community, and help every young people believe and grow in their understanding of the great and awesome God and His gospel message.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee and participate in Emerging Generations (EG) youth ministries (including various camps and youth leadership retreats), and Youth Sunday School
- Build, train, recruit and mentor volunteers to carry out the mission, vision and strategy of Vancouver Chinese Pentecostal Church (VCPC)
- Preach and teach God's Word with clarity and conviction in Sunday morning worship services (<6 Sundays/year)
- Collaborate with worship leaders and the pastoral team to carry out the overall vision of corporate worship
- Attend staff and other meetings as required
- Provide administrative leadership in all areas of church life

Core Competencies:

- **Ministry Ability** – ability to minister and guide in the spiritual growth of the Children's ministries of VCPC; ability to be a model and train believers in missions and evangelism
- **Commitment** – commitment to serve under the church's mission, vision and core values and the VCPC Constitution and Statement of Faith; and to fulfill the duties required of VCPC members as outlined in the membership covenant
