JOB DESCRIPTION: Associate Campus Minister

The role of the associate campus minister would be to support the director in establishing a missional and discipling community on the university campus; providing pastoral care to students; encouraging growth and maturity in discipleship to Jesus; participating in effective outreach and service to the campus; contributing to community building events; and developing new initiatives as needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Leadership Development

- Provide regular mentoring and discipleship for student leaders.
- Lead a discipleship or evangelism small group.

Pastoral Care

- Attend weekly staff meeting.
- Participate in weekly Thursday Night or Tuesday worship gathering.
- Provide pastoral care for university students in the ministry.

Outreach Ministry

- Participate in public campus outreach and training for students (display table, surveys, mission trips, etc.).

QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates would have:

- Evangelical foundation.
- Ministry experience.
- University/college degree.

COMPENSATION:

Hours: Full-time (37.5 hrs/wk)
